BRAILLE LEARNING CLASSES

OUR SPOKEN ENGLISH TRAINING AND PERSONALITY DEVELOPMENT TRAINING

WE4YOU believes that proper training at the apt time can enable the children with visual impairment to stand against every ordeals of the society and lead a life with dignity and self-respect. From 21st May till 19th June, nearly 25 blind students were provided training for improving their soft skills, Spoken English and computer knowledge. For computer training Mr. Rabi Saha, (Computer trainer with visual impairment) ; Sushree Sangita, Sikruti Parija, Sabir Mishra and Amita Singh provided soft skill training as well as Spoken English training to the children. IT LITERACY TRAINING CLASSES FOR VISUALLY IMPAIRED STUDENTS

There are many visually impaired graduates who are way apart from computer use. Through the IT Literacy training program, students get complete training of computer use through NVDA medium. This is a 3 months program where students from PAN India come and get accommodation, fooding and training here at our centre. The training is provided by the well affiliated trainers from Enable India.
